program is tailored to the specific position that the leader holds. It provides the specialized knowledge a new leader needs to assume a leadership role.

Position Specific Training

for Cub Scout leaders can be taken online; for Boy Scout and Venturing leaders, you can attend a training taught by informed volunteers on a district or council level.

Position Specific Training should be taken after <u>Youth Protection Training</u> and <u>This is</u> Scouting

Because each position's responsibilities are different, the time of the training can vary from two to six hours.
