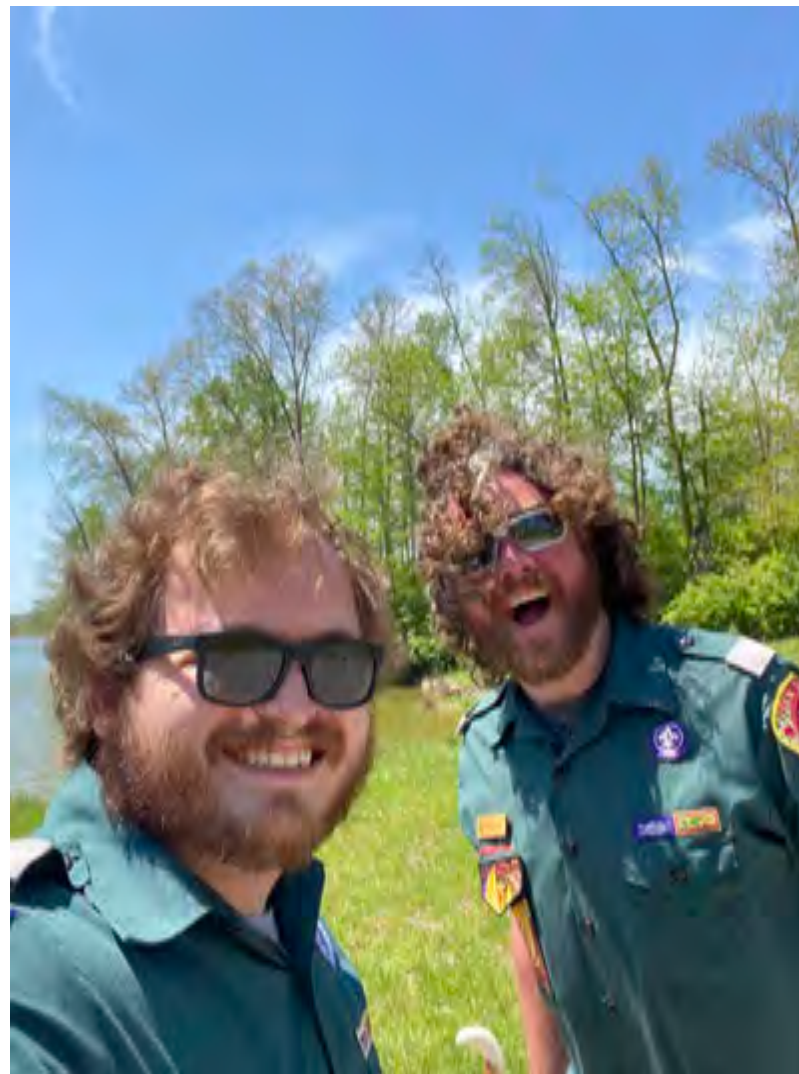

# Assumptions with COVID

- Flexibility is key
- We are constantly monitoring the situation and are planning on a full season at this point



# Refund Policy

- **The policy will be similar to last year**
  - **Only change is that we are asking for 30 days notice if you are no longer planning to attend camp**
- **Right now, you can sign up with little to no risk to you!**



# FAQ

- **Will we get to chose what campsite we stay at?**
  - **Yes! Absolutely. Each site has its own unique qualities that make it desirable to units**
- **Are all campsites indoors?**
  - **No, the castle and the fort are both indoors but Miners Camp and Mountain Man Village are outdoors. All have cots and mattresses and the outdoor campsites provide their own tents**
- **How many adults do I need to bring?**
  - **1 Adult with every 5 youth but a minimum of 2 per pack**
- **Is there running water and hot showers?**
  - **Yes, Cub World has multiple shower houses that are all equipped with multiple showers and water heaters. Running, clean, drinkable water is available all over camp**
